

12. FORMS

This section of the Rulebook contains copies of various forms that apply to all or many of the event types. Forms specific to one event type can be found in that section of the Rulebook. Forms 12.1. through 12.7. are designed so that they can be expanded to a 8.5" X 11" size by copying them using a zoom of 142% to 155% (5.5" to 8.5"). Forms that are laid out the other way on the page, such as the Concours Judging sheets, are designed so that they can be expanded to a 8.5" X 11" size by copying them using a zoom of 129% (8.5" to 11"). Form 12.8. is designed to be copied in its original size (100%) and kept in the Rulebook for usage as the competition year progresses.
